April has arrived and along with it we are beginning a new CERT class. This is going to be a full class. CERT had a training call up the last weekend of March and the response was very good. CERT members are now going to train at least once per quarter.

During the month of March, ten volunteers assisted Cpl. Hoerth and I with a door to door campaign to increase our neighborhood crime watch groups. The results of the door to door campaign are yet to be determined, but we covered almost two hundred fifty homes in about an hour and a half.

Most teams were done within forty five minutes. If the efforts prove fruitful, we may try to replicate this effort.

This door to door campaign was conducted with members from First Baptist Church of Euless. The Church's purpose in going door to door to promote the house they are rehabilitating in the neighborhood as part of the Hometown Project. I accompanied two fourteen year olds. The reception we received at every door was very warm. The children were somewhat nervous when talking, but the residents were very encouraging allowing them to say what they needed to. It warmed my heart over as to the reception that we received from everyone my team contacted.
