- Total - 126 Hours 55 Minutes**

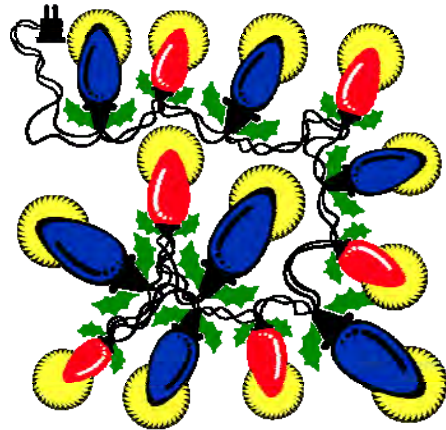

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Fund Raising Report:

Rose-Marie also mentioned that we will have the opportunity to volunteer at Bass Pro Shops from March 1-9. She will have more details after the first of the year.

EXECUTIVE UPDATES:

The announcement will be made to the media on December 5 at 9:30 am at South Eulesss Elementary. KXAS-TV and the Star Telegram will be at the event.

 5. A motion was made by Tim Stinneford that the Association purchase two 12 X 12 bricks this year, one for the City of Euless and the other for NYPD. Second by David Mishkin. Passed. Tim Stinneford also made a motion that the Executive Board should be responsible for the wording on each brick. Second by Mary Kruger. Passed.
 6. Brick Orders: Anyone still wanting to get a brick needs to have their order in by December 20.
 7. Leah Benoit mentioned that the 2003 State Convention forms were available.
 8. Geri Sorg, Budget Chairperson, presented the proposed 2003 Budget. After discussing, a motion was made by Bob Bouse to accept the 2003 Budget as presented, with the Membership Dues being changed to \$1600 and making Total Income \$20,000. Second by Tim Stinneford. Passed.
 9. Sgt. Pavlik asked that if anyone has a question about the budget, to please email the Executive Board. He also mentioned that all the Class photos should be displayed in the Police Training Room next month. Class #16 to graduate on Thursday, November 21. Sgt. Pavlik also thanked Don, Al, Chris and Lou for assisting with the street lights. He also said that the participation in assisting at the Police Department is greatly appreciated.
 10. Geri Sorg mentioned that 14 chiefs and 1 sergeant attended the Regional Roundtable Meeting last month. She also mentioned that some cities are using warrants to earn extra income. Geri mentioned that she will be attending a meeting for the State Convention on Tuesday, November 26. Anyone wanting to attend should meet at the Police Department. Geri has also volunteered the Association to provide 100 baskets for the State Convention.
 11. Don Martin mentioned that we have over 40 people signed up to participate in the COP program. At this time there are very few people volunteering. Don said volunteers could be used anytime!
 12. It was mentioned that Faye Stinneford would have the Association's merchandise available for purchase at every meeting.
 13. Lou Baum showed off 8 new two way radios that were donated by Midland Radio Corporation, a value of \$1,000.00. The radios will be valuable at Arbor Daze and other events.
