



live in the Morrisdale Estate Neighborhood. Lou has been involved with so many other organizations you wonder when he has time to sleep or even be at home. You may want to sit down for the following is just a sampling of how busy Lou stays. He is President/COB of The World Life Foundation. The Family Foundation disseminates information on metabolic diseases to parents and/or patients and assists in ground/air transportation to treatment centers all over North America. Their Foundation has secured the lives of over 1,000 children since 1991 and all these services are free. The Foundation was featured in the National American Profile Magazine as their Hometown Hero in 2001.

In 1998, President Ronald Reagan requested Lou serve and assist the National Commission on Rare Diseases. This committee impacted decisions on Medical Research, Health Care, Medical Treatments, Professional Educational Needs, Public Education and Health Care Insurance Coverage. Lou served with representatives from the National Institutes, the FDA, Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and from the National School of Medicine.

Lou was appointed by the Secretary of Health to serve on the Consortium on Rare Diseases (CORD) in Washington, D.C. The Consortium created and disseminated the First Rare Disease Information Directory and Guidelines for Rare Diseases for the Free


World. The National Child Labor Committee awarded the prestigious Lewis Hine Award by the National Child Labor Committee. This award is given to only five individuals nationally per year who improve the lives of children around the Free World. The Mayor of Euless accompanied Lou to Washington where he received the award.

Lou grew up in Joplin, Missouri and graduated from Joplin High School. He immediately signed a Major League Baseball Contract with the Washington Senators, reporting directly to the Parent Club. He played with and became close personal friends with Mickey Mantle. Just think Lou, you could have been a Texas Ranger!

Lou's career, the paid one, not the volunteer one, includes the following; J.C. Penny's for 18 years, Regional Manager for two National Furniture Manufacturing Companies for 15 years and two years as Chief Operating Officer for a large Health Care Company before he ever came to the City of Euless.




