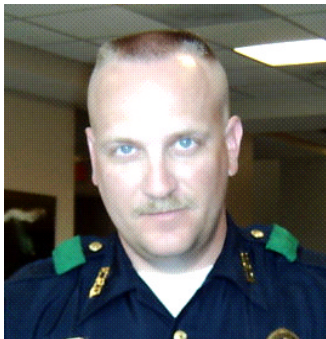

If you volunteered to wrap presents at Bass Pro, please if you can't make it, please let me or J.R. know so we can find a replacement.

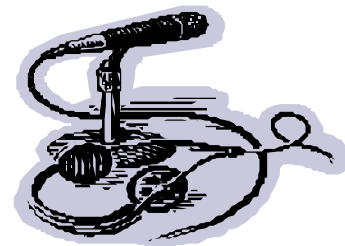
