"Yeah, we have a quota. Two more tickets and my wife gets a toaster oven."



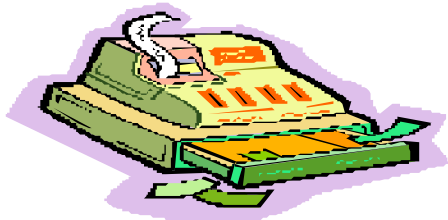
"No sir we don't have quotas anymore. We used to have quotas but now we're allowed to write as many tickets as we want."

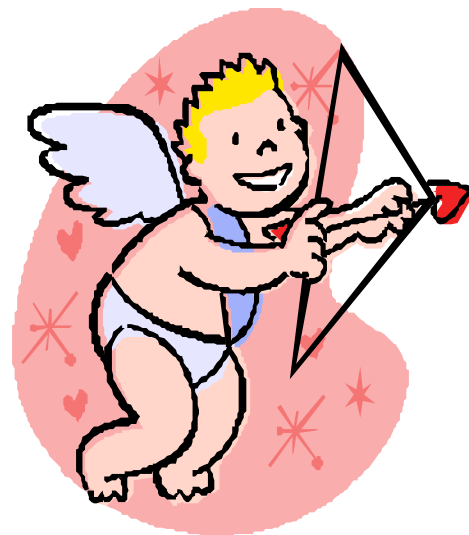
COP Update: Cindy needs more volunteers to ride out on Fridays and evenings.
