The common theme is they want to develop a relationship with the members of our police department, which is one of the positive aspects of law enforcement.

I recently sent an email on a SKYWARN presentation that will be useful to our CERT members. This will serve as our quarterly training for the first part of the year. This is put on by Gary Woodall from the National Weather Service. NBC 5, Telemundo 39 Weather Teams, and the Tarrant County Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Services will also be speaking. This event will be held at the Lake Arlington Baptist Church, 2912 Little Road in Arlington on Saturday February 3 from 7:45 AM thru 4:30 PM. You will each receive a certificate of training. This is a no-cost training session, and lunch will be provided at the church by Dickie's Barbecue. We will be taking both police vans for those who want to ride from the police department.

You may recall seeing footage back in August of 2006 from an apartment complex in Midlothian, where a suspect was firing upon several Midlothian officers and Texas State Troopers, who moved in to assist. This incident lasted most of the night and left three Midlothian Officers and a Trooper wounded due to gunshot wounds. The Trooper is Rick Smith who works out of Midlo-

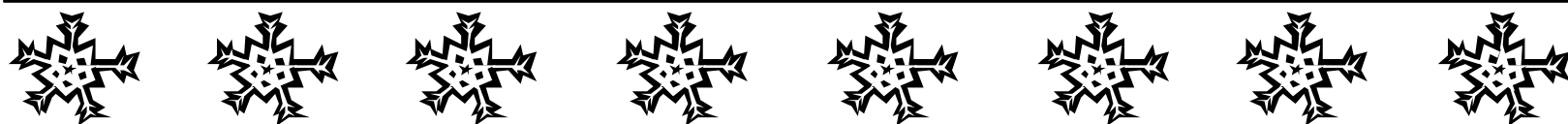

Police Officer Jermaine L. Montgomery

Jermaine has been with the Euless PD for nearly 7 years. He has worked uniformed Bicycle Patrol and is currently a Tactical Team Member.

He was born in New Orleans, LA in 1972. He has two older brothers and a younger sister. He resides in Fort Worth with his new wife, who is an Environmentalist Technician at a TXU nuclear plant. Children are in the future, but for now they have a Blue Russian cat named "Luna" - short for lunatic.

Jermaine has a Bachelor of Science degree in Sociology and a minor in Criminal Justice. He previously worked for the City of New Orleans Fire Department as a Fire Fighter II/Medical First Responder and for Jefferson Parish School Board as a 9th/10th grade teacher (AKA "Zoo Instruc-

tor"). He received a New Orleans Fire Department award for overall highest academic and physical fitness achievement, and first place Physical Fitness award for Fireman Challenge competition.

The thing he likes most about his job as a police officer is the never-ending ability of learning how to apply and/or develop solutions that work for everyone involved in an incident. He credits this ability to his experienced and knowledgeable supervisors, co-workers, and his own past experiences.

What he likes least about his job is when individuals leave no alternative but to arrest them for a crime, knowing that every criminal action causes not just a single effect that directly and indirectly affects some other element of their lives and/or those closest to them.

In his career with the Euless PD, he aspires to gain as much knowledge and experience in all specialized fields of law enforcement and utilize those

assets to be promoted as high as possible within the department. He also wants to teach and share his learning with others in order to have better informed and better prepared personnel.

Jermaine's favorite quote, "Let's roll!", means that he's willing and always ready. "I may appear to be a big, possibly intimidating, standoffish type, somewhat intelligent - believe me, it's all for show. I'm really average standing next to my college football buddies. I'm afraid of big spiders. I love people as long as they are not ignorant and closed-minded." 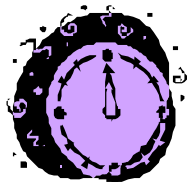
It is a Tuesday in January at 2 p.m. School is in session. Euless is under a severe weather warning and, in addition to heavy rain and pea-sized hail, we are experiencing terrible winds. The storm shorts the electricity in Lushaj’s Pizza at 157 and Harwood, and causes a disaster in the shopping complex. EPD and EFD are handling all major aspects of the disaster, but their limited resources are exhausted. The Police Chief activates CERT.

- ◆ Can the EPD quickly reach you? Is your contact information on file correct?
- ◆ Is your CERT bag packed, ready, and easy to access?
- ◆ Do you have raingear and footwear ready? Can you adequately protect your body from the elements?
- ◆ Do you have a personal supply of water and snacks to refresh your energy level during your CERT work? Is it easy to grab and throw in your backpack?

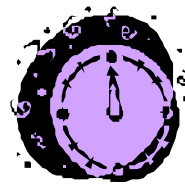

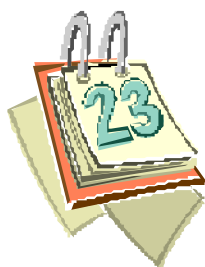
