She is going to start by offering the class broken down into two three hour training blocks on Thursday night. ## From the President

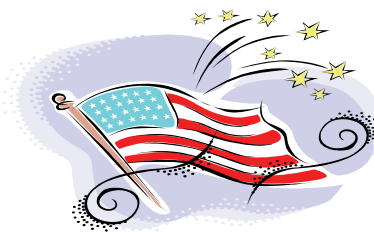
### Denise Miles

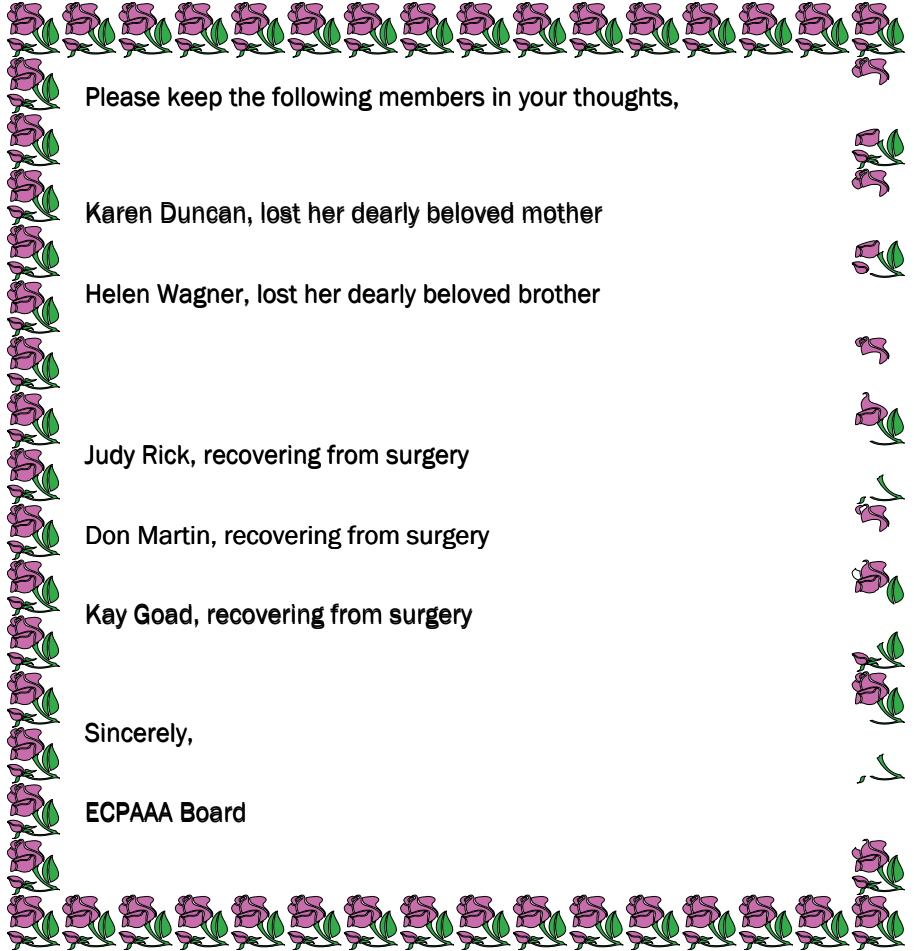
The next time you see a flag flown high in the blue sky, say a silent thank you to the men and women who serve our communities and neighborhoods every single day.

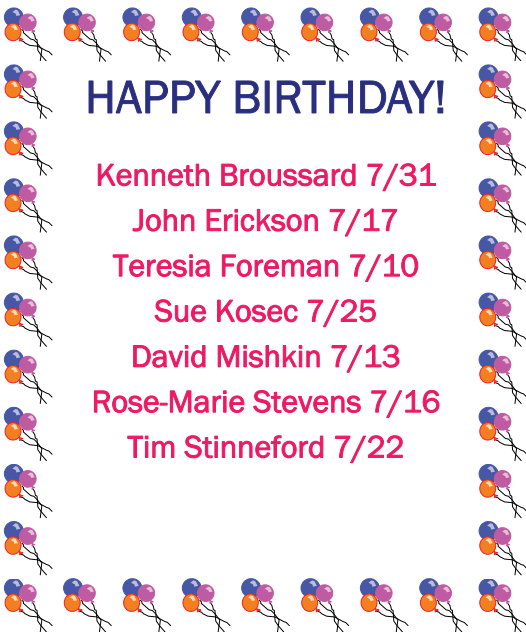
