Plans are under way to provide healthy on the go food for the officers on Sunday and Thursday of that week, so each shift change will be able

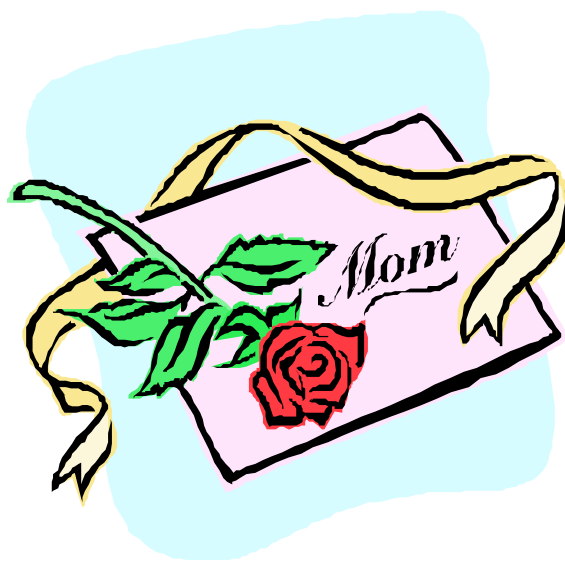
to participate in the goodies.

**LIASION** - Gary spoke about the importance of Arbor Daze. He gave everyone an assignment, go home and contact one person to see if they could help out at Arbor Daze. We have 84 paid members and this is our most important fundraiser. Gary mentioned the awards given out at the Police Awards Banquet on April 15th see list on page 3. Chief Carmack spoke of the 2005-2006 fiscal year budget and he also made us aware of his wish list. The list will be presented to the City Manager and he may need our help depending on what is approved. Needed are: **1**- 2 new dispatchers-have not hired in last 15 years. More officers have been hired and cities around us have grown. **2**-Patrol needs AR15's for officers who qualify (approx 15). **3**-Less than lethal - Tasers for those trained. **4**- Video enhancement machine to update qualify of store tapes. **5**- New updated Polygraph machine. **6**-Crime site—Bill Richardson item to lift prints and transfer to aphis. **7**-Replace H&K MP5— Tac Team-new enhancement where AR15 can be used in apartments. **8**-Need new Patrol Car top with radar and light. City of Eules covers 16 sq. miles. **9**-Need stop sticks for chase situations that help deter a car from trying to run. New Technology. Question was raised regarding a recent newspaper article mentioning Eules had loaned an ambulance to Bedford. Chief explained we have an agreement with Bedford for ambulances.
