need of a non budgeted expense that is crucial in  
their training needs. The cost will be \$2121.99.  
The items needed are 10 striking bags, 10 red  
handle guns, 10 striking batons and 4 ARIS.  
This will allow 15 officers to be trained at a time.  
This amount is higher than the amount allotted  
for the shadow boxes.

J. R. reported if we sell 75 bricks we would net  
\$1700.00 which would be a big part of the  
money needed for this expenditure. We have 87  
paid members in our organization. This net is  
based on a \$35.00 brick. A motion was made by  
Faye Stinneford to meet this request. Second by  
Charley LaFontaine. Passed.

J.R. reported he has spoken with Bass Pro and  
we need to make a commitment if we plan to  
wrap packages at the store during the Christmas  
holidays. It was agreed to invite the Fire Depart-  
ment to join us and J. R. will make up a sched-  
ule. It was suggested we have ribbon ahead of  
time and those unable to do the wrapping and  
commit to hours worked at the store could help  
by making up bows in advance.

newly trained members ready and out on the

need to help by bringing side dishes.

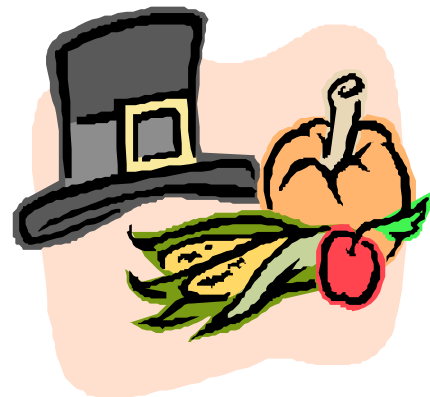
Money Raiser idea was presented to sell tickets
