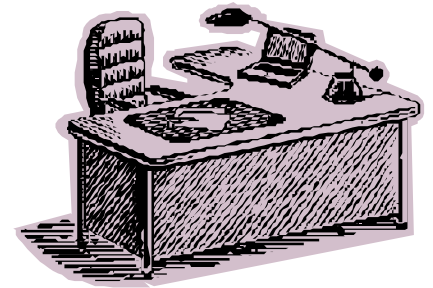

FUNDRAISER: Leah announced that Julie Watkins had ordered 200 throws and they should arrive in a couple of weeks.

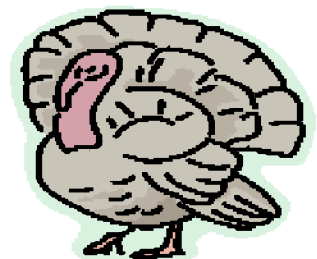

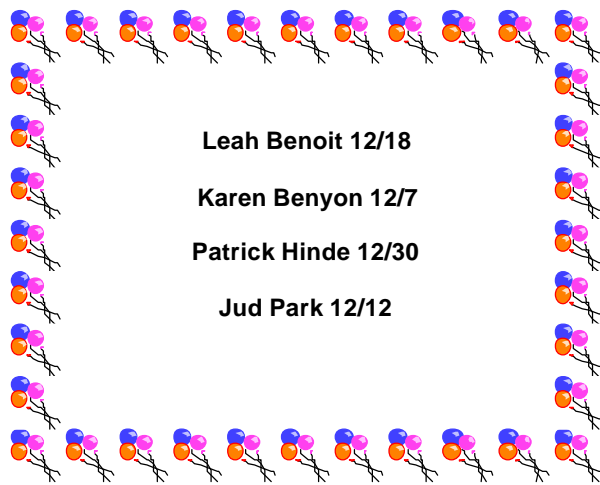
