



### CPAANT Liaison — Leah Benoit – November 5, 2016 — Lewisville

The meeting was held at the Fred Herring Rec Center and there were approximately 40 people in attendance representing 14 cities. The speaker was Texas Trooper Sgt. Kyle Bradford and he spoke about Distracted Driving.

Sgt. Bradford showed videos of motor vehicle accidents that were caused by distracted driving. Distracted driving is defined as operating a motor vehicle while allowing anything to take your attention from driving. Driving while distracted affects the driver in three ways: 1) Perception, 2) Judgment and 3) Action. He also gave some Texas statistics and here are a few:



3,531 deaths in 2015

476 people killed involving distracted driving in 2015

246,335 persons injured in motor vehicle traffic crashes in 2015

There were no deathless days in 2015, meaning there was not a day where someone was not killed in a traffic accident.

#### A few national statistics:

98% adults text compared to 43% teenagers

6,000 juveniles are killed every year in motor vehicle crashes

6 Billion cell phone users in 2012

7 Trillion texts are sent every minute

Can anyone guess what kills our youths more than guns, drugs and alcohol? If anyone is thinking car keys, you are correct.
