CERT Challenge

Home Safety -- Fall and Winter Tips

CERT trains citizens to prepare for emergency situations and to help keep our homes and communities safe. Please read the following home safety tips --you just might learn something new!

- Check your homeowners insurance policy and be sure that you have adequate coverage for your needs in case of emergency or fire.
- Take a look at the filters in your heating system. If they are dirty, clean or change them right away. A dirty filter can make your system more expensive to operate. It can also damage your heating equipment.
- Make a thorough check of your home's insulation before winter comes. Add more insulation, or replace old insulation as needed, to save on energy bills.
- Check for cracks, gaps and crevices in your home (doors, windows, and so on), then fill them in with caulk or other sealants. This will guard against drafts and keep your heating bills low.
- In the wintertime, keep an eye on your thermostat. Most experts recommend heating your home to 68 degrees.
- If you use an electric heater, be sure not to overload the circuit. Only use extension cords which have the necessary rating to carry the amp load.
- Avoid using electric space heaters in bathrooms or other areas where they may come in contact with water.
- Keep young children safely away from space heaters, especially when they are wearing nightgowns or other loose clothing that can be easily ignited.
- Have the chimney inspected annually and cleaned if necessary, especially if it has not been used for some time.
- Do not use flammable liquids to start or accelerate any fire in your fireplace.
- Keep a glass or metal screen in front of the fireplace opening to prevent embers or sparks from jumping out, unwanted material from going in, and help prevent the possibility of bums to occupants.
- Keep flammable materials away from your mantel. A spark from the fireplace could easily ignite these materials.

mills and robot repair.


The Presidential Award list is being compiled. Anyone close to the 100 hours needs to get the hours in
